

As of September 20th, 2021 attendance of all events held at Kitchen by Brad Smoliak or hosted by Kitchen by Brad Smoliak will require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test upon entry.

On September 15th, 2021, the Government of Alberta declared a State of Public Health Emergency to protect the health care system. Along with this declaration, new public health restrictions were put into place. We have chosen to take part in the 'Restriction Exemption Program' (REP).

As of September 20th, 2021, Kitchen by Brad will be able to operate without restriction, serve any individual eligible for vaccination who:

- Has proof of double vaccination
- Has documentation of a medical exemption; or
- Has proof of a recent (within the previous 72 hours) negative COVID-19 test (either PCR or Rapid Test). The test may not be from Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories.
- For those under 12 will not need to provide proof of immunization or a negative test upon entrance.
- **MASKS WILL STILL BE REQUIRED unless eating or drinking.**

To enter spaces participating in the Restrictions Exemption Program, people ages 12 and older can provide proof of vaccination or documentation of a medical exemption.

- Provincial, Territorial or Federal issued immunization cards. Please note: no information will be stored or shared.
- We will accept 'hard copy' vaccination papers/certificates/cards, as long as your name and birthdate are clear and visible, and match your government issued photo identification. Please note: no information will be stored or shared.
- If you would like to access your card-sized COVID record, visit [this website](#). You only need your health number, date of birth, and the month of your COVID vaccine (either dose). There is no wait for this service, and you can either show the printed card or a screenshot on your phone.
- Photographs of your 'hard copy' vaccination papers/certificate/card as long as your name and birthdate are clear and visible, and match your government issued photo identification. Please note: no information will be stored or shared.
- Immunization records on apps such as: <https://myhealth.alberta.ca/myhealthrecords> or any other Provincial, Territorial or Federal application. Please note: no information will be stored or shared, and these applications may take several weeks to upload your

immunization records, and may possible have a long wait time to access. Due to this we will also accept a screenshot of COVID immunizations from Government Issued applications.

To enter spaces participating in the Restrictions Exemption Program, people aged 12 and older can show proof of a negative test result.

- Tests must be privately-paid COVID-19 PCR or rapid tests completed within 72 hours.
- Tests must not be from Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories.
